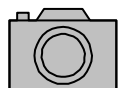

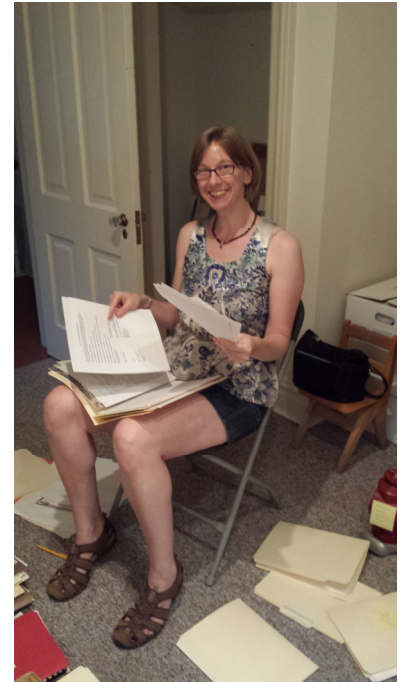


SUMMER ARCHIVE WORK

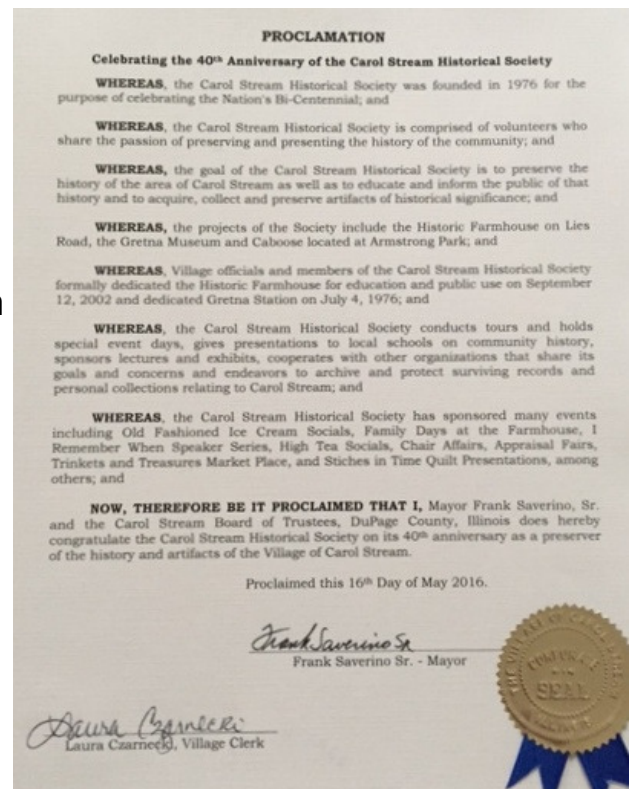
